PURPOSE: The purpose of this Articulation Agreement is to establish the terms and conditions under which credit earned through completion of Midlands Technical College's Associates of Applied Science Degree in Management will be applied to Columbia International University's Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration (to be offered beginning Fall 2018).

- The agreement may also be amended with the consent of both institutions.
- If there has been no activity for the previous five years, then the program and agreement will be terminated and a review for renewal is not required.
