Financial Aid Reminders

- Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year at <u>fafsa.ed.gov</u> for the Financial Aid Office to award grants, loans, and need-based scholarships.
- Login to my.ciu.edu and click on the My Financial Aid link in the left margin. Accept or decline your awards and complete any necessary documents.
- August 1 FAFSA submission deadline for SC residents receiving SC Tuition Grant
- CIU FAFSA school code = 003429

Eligibility Requirements

- You must be enrolled full time (12 credit hours) in a degree-seeking program to receive CIU scholarships and grants.
- SC Life Scholarship recipients must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA and earn an average of 30 credit hours per academic year.
- Federal loans require a student to be enrolled at least half time (six credit hours) in a degree seeking program. A change in enrollment status after funds are disbursed may require repayment of all or a portion of your award.

Welcome to CIU Accounting

The CIU Accounting Office provides friendly assistance with your student account through the Cashier's Office, where you can pay your tuition and fees, or set up a payment plan for the semester. If you have questions about your student charges, we are here to help.

What new students should know:

- All tuition and fees are due by August 15 for the Fall semester and January 15 for the Spring semester.
- You have the option of setting up a payment plan for the semester.
- Students will incur a \$75 late fee if tuition and fees are not received on time.
- The Accounting Office follows the CIU Academic Calendar in reference to refund schedules of add/drop and withdrawal deadlines. You can access the Academic Calendar at my.ciu.edu/ICS/Registrar/Academic_Calendar.jnz

How to View your Student Account Statement:

Your student account statement is available at any time during the semester. Sign in to your my.ciu.edu account and click on the **Finances tab**. You will find your statement under **My Financial Account**.

How to make a payment:

For your convenience, the Accounting Office accepts cash, personal checks, money orders and credit cards. A convenience fee will be charged on all card payments. Checks should be made payable to Columbia International University.

How to Pay for Classes in Person:

The Accounting Office accepts payments Monday through Friday (excluding holidays), between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. at the Cashier's office in the CIU Administration building.

Paying tuition by E-Check, debit card, or credit card

- 1. Sign in to your <u>my.ciu.edu</u> account and select the Finances tab then "Make Payment."
- 2. Enter the payment amount and payment method then click "Continue payment checkout." Note: To make a payment plan payment make sure the box beside your payment plan name is selected. Enter the amount you want to pay in the field across from the payment due date.
- 3. You will be directed to a new page to complete the Payment Form
- 4. Enter your payment and billing information then click "Pay Now." Note: Make sure to enter a valid email address to receive your receipt via email.

Setting up a payment plan for the current semester:

- 1. Sign in to your <u>my.ciu.edu</u> and click on the Finances tab.
- Select PAYMENT PLANS. You will be directed to a new page to setup your account with Nelnet.
- Review the payment plan details. To select the plan, you are currently viewing, click 'Choose Plan'
- 4. Review the Terms and Conditions.
- 5. A box will appear allowing you to review your plan details. To accept, select 'Yes, consent.'



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I view my bill?

You will need to log into your portal and select the finances tab, then account statement and then select my account statement (PDF). Be sure you are looking at the correct term.

Is it okay if I pay by check?

Yes. Make checks payable to Columbia International University. Include the student ID# and Term in the memo line. Please mail at least one week early to ensure payment is posted on or before due date.

Does CIU offer a monthly payment Plan?

Yes. Students and their families may pay in monthly installments. View the various options of payment at Payment Plan Options. Log into your portal and select finances, and then select make a payment/payment plan.

If I have applied for loans, scholarships, or other financial aid that are not reflected on the billing invoice, what should I do?

Sometimes financial aid is not reflected on a student's bill because they have not completed the required paperwork. For question regarding missing financial aid, please contact the Financial Aid Office at (803) 807-5036. For private scholarships, please follow-up with the person or organization that awarded you the scholarship.

How do I get a 1098-T Tuition Statement and Statement Account history?

Your tax form 1098T will be available on the Student Portal on January 31. A statement history is available on the Student Portal by selecting finances, then 1098-T form. Be sure to select the correct term in which you need statement history.




