Policy Statement

An alumna/us (defined as having earned 12+ credits) may be eligible to receive certain benefits based on their alumni status.

Rationale

Offering benefits to alumni draws them back to campus and shows an appreciation for their time spent on campus.

Policy Procedures

Alumni benefits include the following:

- Three meal tickets per calendar year (per alumna/alumnus)
- One free night in the guestrooms per calendar year (per family)
- Discounted membership to the fitness center.
- Free access to the computer labs
- · Access to the online job board
- Library guest pass
- One course audit per semester for application fee only. Some restrictions apply. They may only audit a course up to the level of their CIU obtained degree. (<u>Audit Policy Link</u>)
