

The Financial Aid Proration Guide is a resource that outlines the CIU Scholarships available for undergraduate online, graduate, and seminary students as well as how aid is prorated for different types of CIU Scholarships based on the number of credit hours taken in a semester. Most degree programs have a Fall, Spring, and Summer semester with the exception of Master of Organizational Leadership (MOL) and Master of Business Administration (MBA) will Fall and Spring semesters. The guide helps to show how financial aid packages may be recalculated by adding or dropping courses in a semester.

Federal & State Aid:

- Students must be registered for at least the following semester hours and be degree-seeking to qualify for federal loans:
 - Undergraduate = 6 credit hours
 - Graduate = 4.5 credit hours
 - Advanced = 1.5 credit hours
- Undergraduate students may be eligible to receive a Federal Pell Grant. The amount is determined by enrollment status, income, dependency, etc.
- Certain SC Resident students may qualify for the South Carolina Tuition Grant, SC LIFE Scholarship, or SC HOPE Scholarship. Undergraduate students must be starting in the Fall term and registered for 12 semester hours
- Changes in enrollment status (adding/dropping courses) may affect Federal and State Aid.

Additional Aid Information:

- An active duty, veteran, or spouse may be eligible for military scholarships with available military funding up to the cost of tuition. The awarding of military scholarships is contingent on submission of a DD-214 or other proof of service document that indicates the student was honorably discharged. In the case of active-duty students, they must supply recent orders, LES, or other proof of service. Military IDs are prohibited from being used as proof of military service.
- Student athletes receiving athletic scholarships are not eligible for non-athletic scholarships.
- To be eligible for financial aid, students must meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP).
